We are a diverse community comprised of over 150 students and 26 faculty and staff members.

Tuition is determined after acceptance and is based on a family's ability to pay.

Our admission policy is need-blind, which means a family's financial status is not considered when making admissions decisions. Ninety percent of the operating budget is funded by sources other than tuition. With the support of caring and dedicated teachers, students are introduced to an innovative yet challenging academic curriculum, strong core values, and character development, all while fostering a sense of community. Our students are:

When admitting new students, we look at several areas: the student report card, academic recommendations, admissions test scores, and the personal interview.

It is important to us that we admit students who will be able to have a successful academic experience as well as a willingness to fully participate in the DLSA community. Students at De La Salle Academy receive individualized schedules which consist of three core courses (ELA, Math, and World Languages) taught five periods a week. All students participate in special topics classes, as well as extracurricular activities and clubs. With a student/faculty ratio of 9:1, our average class size of 17 students promotes the cultivation of meaningful student-teacher relationships. In addition to academic courses and extracurriculars, students are enriched through programs that encourage the development of leadership skills, supportive relationships with peers and adults, and mental health.
